ADVANCE PROSTATE CANCER IS A SERIOUS DISEASE

Dr. Sebastien Hotte, Head of the Phase I Program at Juravinski Cancer Centre in Hamilton says, "Advanced prostate cancer is usually cancer that started within the prostate, but then has moved beyond where the organ was, into places such as the lymph nodes or the bones."

ADVANCE PROSTATE CANCER IS OFTEN MISUNDERSTOOD

Dr. Hotte says many of his patients with advanced prostate cancer have concerns that they "will die with prostate cancer, but never from prostate cancer. Unfortunately, men, often younger men, have a more aggressive form of the prostate cancer and the likelihood of it spreading to the blood stream and then going elsewhere and becoming generalized, increases."

THERE IS NO CURE

Dr. Hotte understands that "advanced prostate cancer can be quite earth shattering and life changing for patients and their families. More often than not, patients will pass away from their cancer and it is a cancer that we cannot make it go away."

NEW TREATMENT OPTIONS


"Until recently, men with advanced prostate cancer did not have options outside of the clinical trial. We now have two new medications that can help these men with advanced prostate cancer." Dr. Hotte believes this is important because, "men that are diagnosed with advanced prostate cancer are still not going to be cured from their cancer with newer treatments. However, they are very likely to live a much longer life and a much better life than the men diagnosed with the same disease, 10 years ago."

TAKE ACTION

Dr. Hotte urges all men speak with their doctor; "it is very important, especially for younger men, to be very vigilant about their own health and to receive proper medical attention and to get screened."
